Andado Station is the largest privately owned cattle station in Australia, comprising 10,800sq km. It has areas of the Simpson Desert and Finke River floodout, running Brahman cattle - the most southern station to do so.

Old Andado Station is owned by Mollie Clarke, widow of Mac Clarke. It is a 10,000 acre plot. The unique factor is that it is still furnished and stocked with artifacts from the early 50's and appears complete with Mollies possessions and books. The Homestead is now Heritage Listed.

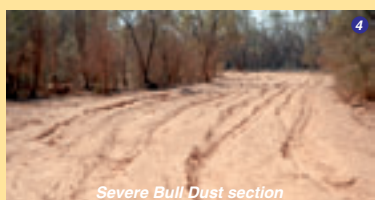

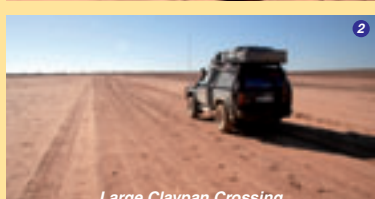

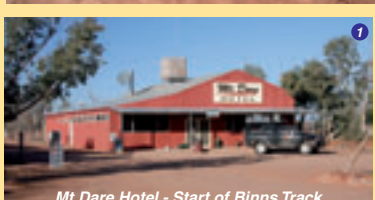
