## PEDIRKA DESERT

Numerous sandhill crests on the track to Pedirka Turn-off make travelling slower due to on-coming traffic, possible animals on or crossing the track and the bad corrugations throughout the area. The sand hills are part of the Pedirka Desert which extends into this area.

Caution: Beware of Roadtrains

Fogartys Claypan can be a difficult area to drive across in the wet. The surface is very soft and boggy and with the distance across the area approximately 3 km, can be very challenging, if not hazardous in the wrong weather conditions. A Detour track is provided to avoid this problem, particularly for those towing caravans and trailers. During the dry, hot times, the surface is very dusty.
